

An exciting opportunity to join a church in a new season of ministry and mission.







DISCIPLE

Disciple our young people, helping them grow and deepen their relationship with Jesus by developing and implementing a teaching programme that is in line with St Paul's vision and values. Provide informed and targeted pastoral care to young people during incredibly important and formative years. Work with our Children's and Families' Pastor to implement discipleship pathways across all our ministry to under 18s.

REACH

Reach the young people of Camberley by pioneering missional initiatives across the parish and inspiring the church family to be involved. This includes devloping the relationships we currently have with local secondary schools into fruitful evangelism opportunities.

This is a full-time role that includes some evenings and Sundays.
