

An exciting opportunity to join a church in a new season of ministry and mission.





Camberley encounter God and experience hope.' We believe young people are so important in this vision!


During the appointment of the new vicar, the church felt God was calling them to bring young people closer to the centre of the church family. We are seeking a Youth Worker to help enable our ministry to young people and help us in this call.



During a vacancy in leadership, our youth ministry is currently stripped back in order to serve our young people wholeheartedly with limited resources. We are looking for a dynamic youth worker to help our youth work reach its potential, investing in our team of volunteers and seeing young people know Jesus and grow as disciples.

We currently employ a Children's and Families' pastor and have seen great growth in this area in recent years with many new families joining St Paul's. We long to see this work developed as the children reach their teenage years.





Historically, St Paul's Camberley has been engaged with local mission beyond the parish, running youth groups and worship nights with Surrey Heath Deanery. We have also provided mentoring in a local secondary school in partnership with Camberley Youth for Christ.

Our next youth worker will be a worshipping member of our church family, and will inspire the whole church to support and participate in youth ministry as we seek numerical and spiritual growth.

St Paul's has a long tradition of developing and enabling young people and youth workers to grow in their faith. You will be loved and supported as a member of our church family! You will also be joining a staff team who pray together regularly, retreat annually, and are great fun to work with.

We are looking for a gifted youth worker with an inspiring passion to build on our strong foundations of youth ministry. Your main responsibilities and tasks will be to...

#### **DISCIPLE**

Disciple our young people, helping them grow and deepen their relationship with Jesus in line with St Paul's vision and values. Provide informed and targeted pastoral care to young people during incredibly important and formative years. Work with our Children's and Families' Pastor to implement discipleship pathways across all our ministry to under 18s.

#### REACH

Play a key role in helping us discern how we might reach the young people of Camberley with missional initiatives such as youth groups or schools work, and helping us to effectively use our social media to reach young people.

This is a part-time role (20 hours). For the right candidate, we are open to term time only work.

We know that boundaries and self-care are vitally important. Therefore, we commit to ensuring that expectations and responsibilities do not exceed what can be reasonably expected within the 20 hour work week.

You must be eligible to work in the UK to apply for this vacancy.

There is a genuine occupational requirement for the post to be filled by a practising Christian. St Paul's Church is an Anglican Church of England parish church that is part of the New Wine network and is a member of the Evangelical Alliance. We expect applicants to uphold the Evangelical Alliance basis of faith.
